



There are a variety of Special Education programs for students with special needs in the Linden Community School District. A local school district must make such programs available if they are needed by special need students. Linden Community Schools provides services through in-district and out of district facilities. By law, programs are required for persons identified as:

- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Cognitively Impaired
- Severely Multiply Impaired
- Emotionally Impaired
- Hearing Impaired
- Learning Disabled
- Physically Impaired
- Otherwise Health Impaired
- Early Childhood Developmentally Delayed
- Speech and Language Impaired
- Visually Impaired
- Traumatic Brain Injury

In addition to instructional services, the following ancillary and other related services are available:

- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy
- School Social Worker Services
- Transportation
- Homebound Services
- Teacher Consultants
- Speech and Language Pathologists
- Adaptive Physical Education

Not all programs and services will be provided for each student. An Individualized Educational Planning Team (IEPT) determines which program and/or services are appropriate for each student.
